Increased Demand for Digitization/Enterprise Content Management (ECM)


HF Group's AssureVault division has noticed a big upturn in the demand for digitization and Enterprise Content Management (ECM) services. AssureVault President, Dennis Tallerico, says "this is a result of advances in technology as organizations are faced with the need to repurpose space currently used for document storage."

"Efficiency is also a factor, says Tallerico. Searching through boxes to find a single document can take hours. When those records are online, documents can be located in minutes."

We are currently producing 10,000 - 15,000 high-quality scanned images each day, but scanning is only one part of the process. Before scanning can be done, the materials are prepped and, afterwards,"re-prepped" for return to the customer. Scanned images also undergo a strict quality control process.

In addition to digitization, we also provide hard copy storage as well as certified document destruction services, if desired.

2013 World Series Champions

The book, a 2014 PINE award winner, was printed on an HP Indigo digital press with a PUR adhesive binding. The cover features two-color foil stamping, and a debossed panel with a laminated, printed, mounted picture.
