Cybercrime: Creating Human Firewalls with KnowBe4

When it comes to cybercrime, no business is safe. Cyber threats come in many different forms, and attackers use increasingly sophisticated technologies in their attempts to access data and cripple companies. Preventative measures have traditionally been focused on castle-and-moat technology-based solutions, but more and more security awareness plays a critical role.

One of the most common ways in which data breeches occur is through email. To minimize this risk, HF Group has implemented the **KnowBe4 Security Awareness and Training Program** to equip our users with the knowledge and tools to act as <u>human firewalls</u>.

This automated platform trains our employees to understand and recognize the mechanisms of spam, phishing, spear phishing, malware, ransomware, and social engineering, and it helps them apply this knowledge effectively on a day-to-day basis. One of its features is an integrated "**Phish Alert**" button that gives users a safe way to forward suspicious emails to our security team for further analysis and response.



In addition to Security and Awareness Training, we have added KnowBe4's **PhishER** to our security workstream. PhishER serves as a phishing emergency room that identifies and responds to messages reported through **Phish Alert**. It prioritizes and analyzes reported messages, and allows our security team to respond to threats quickly and effectively.
